**Bills' Nautical Origins!** "Let the Cat Out of the Bag"

A sailor found drunk on board was ordered to fashion a cat-O-nine tails or "make a rod for his own back", which would then be kept in a leather bag. When sailors "let the cat out of the bag" they were in for misfortune, usually on Blue Monday (traditionally the day for handing out brutal punishments of the Royal Navy. There was a superstition that evil would befall the ship if the treatment was not delivered on Mondays. Ever hear of having the blues?). The Royal Navy's cat-o-nine tails was kept in a red baize bag, and not removed until the offender was safely secured to the gratings and there was no possibility of reprieve, so "the secret was out." Authority to use the cat was not removed from the Naval Discipline Act until March 29, 1949!
