brau Brewery in Elmhurst. It was at that event where I first met my wife.

Janet Comings has always been a strong person for me. I'll never forget the first Coconut Bowl which was held at the old Fox Lanes in Downers Grove (where Bed Bath and Beyond is now). We were having a difficult time getting people to sign up and I was on the verge of throwing in the towel. Janet, as she did for me many times, talked me off the ledge and many Cocobowls later, you see what has become of the event.

On my last visit with Janet, she expressed her desire that she wanted everyone to be happy. She always thought of others before herself and was completely unselfish in this regard even to the end. I will miss her deeply. The one Buffett song that comes to mind, which I know was a favorite of Janet's, was Jolly Mon -Janet often referred to herself as the Jolly Mom.
