

Here's your drink of the month: Vicki's Secret Surprise

- 2 cups cranberry juice ice cubes
- 1 cup ice cubes
- 1/2 cup tart cherry juice
- 1/2 cup vodka
- 1/3 cup lime juice
- 1/4 cup grand Marnier liqueur
- Fresh cherries and lime slice fro garnish

Blend the cranberry ice cubes, ice cherry juice, vodka, lime juice and Grand Marnier in blender and blend till "slushie". Garnish with lime, cherries and tiny umbrella.
