

Hollywood Park (YUMMY is all I can say)

- 1 ½ ozs Bourbon
- 1 ½ ozs. Simple syrup
- 1 oz fresh lime juice
- ½ oz. cognac
- 5 mint leaves

Combine the bourbon, simple syrup, lime juice, cognac and mint in a shaker and muddle the mint. Simple syrup is equal parts sugar and water and heat till sugar is dissolved then cool. Add ice and shake vigorously.

Double strain over crushed ice and garnish with mint and lime wedge if desired. Enjoy
