IMPORTANT TICKET INFORMATION

Our club is on the list for PHiP tickets to the Tinley Park show on July 21st. Although we do not yet know the number of tickets that our club will be lucky enough to receive, the fact that there is a new club in our regional ticket mix and many clubs have grown significantly, this automatically reduces the number of tickets our club will be eligible to purthose members who have achieved "active member" status will receive first consideration for tickets. Active members must be a member in good standing (dues are current), and since August 2006, will have attended at least three club meetings, helped at one Adopt-a-Highway, and participated in one major charity event. There are still plenty of opportunities to fill all of these requirements, so stay tuned to the newsletter, meetings, and Yahoo Group. Active member status must be achieved by the June club meeting (6-19-07).

Our club will award all tickets for our club, based on the Parrot Point System. Please understand that the Chicago Parrot Head Club does have a ticket policy to distribute the PHiP tickets that we are fortunate enough to purchase and we will strictly adhere to this policy.

Ticket eligibility guidelines are available on the PHiP website at

http://phip.com/leaders_ticke ts.asp but in a nutshell, they are as follows:

- Family or household memberships are eligible for 2 tickets. Single memberships are eligible for 2 tickets, so long as the 2nd ticket is used by a member in good standing of the club.
- In order to be eligible to purchase the tickets, you
 MUST be a Parrot Head club member in good standing.
- Tickets obtained through PHiP CANNOT be sold, given or transferred to anyone, unless that person

is also a member of the Parrot Head Club.

Please understand that you are requesting tickets, and it in no way guarantees that you will receive tickets in the PHiP block. I cannot confirm ticket cost until we get the official word from PHiP, but please plan on paying about \$126 per ticket. Tickets cannot be sold for above face value on the club's Yahoo Group. The traditional cost has been face value + TM charges. This applies to all events, not just Buffett. All questions regarding this should be directed to Crew@chicagoparrotheads.com

Parrot Points/Active Member Status

While it is not guaranteed, whenever possible, Jimmy Buffett's management reserves a block of tickets for sanctioned Parrot Heads in Paradise Clubs at local concerts. We are given a block for the Tweeter Center Concert (usually in the 200 section.) In order to be eligible to purchase these tickets you must reach ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP status each concert year (the date of the Saturday Tweeter Center show that ends the day of the following year's Thursday's show). To be considered an active member you must:

- 1) Attend at least 3 monthly club meetings
- 2) Attend at least one Adopt A Highway Cleanup
- Attend or support at least one major club charity event (i.e...Coconut Bowl, Misericordia, Candy Days, Alzheimer's Memory Walk, St. Jude Radiothon)

From time to time, opportunities or items in limited supply may become available to the club. Members who participate in events and accumulate the most points will have first priority to take advantage of these situations. We have developed the Parrot Point system as a fair method to track participation. Points are awarded as follows:

- Attend a monthly meeting (3 points)
- Attend an Adopt-A-Highway Event (5 points)
- Attend an "official" club social event (2 points)
- Attend a major charity event (5 points)
- Attend a non-major charity event (3 points)
- Sponsor a member for a major charity event (2 points)
- Donate items (2 points) ie...50/50, raffle, pop tops, toiletries, cell phones, etc. (limited to 2 points per meeting)

- Special donations (2 points) ie...clothing drives, food drives, or others as announced.
 - Write a newsletter article (2 points)
 - Refer a new member (5 points)
 - Work at an event (2-5 points)*
- Organize an event (2-5 points)*
- Serve on Pilot House Crew
 (20 points/month)

You must sign in at an event to receive credit for attending. If you have something you think you should get points for, note it on the charitable activities log (points are awarded at the Pilot House Crew's discretion). Each member in a dual membership accumulates points individually. Only one member of a dual membership gets credit for a single donation. Extra points can be awarded at the discretion of the Pilot House Crew. Please see a crew member if you have any questions regarding these policies.
