





In 2011, the first baby boomers will reach their 65th birthdays. By 2029, all baby boomers will be at least 65 years old. This



group, totaling an estimated 70 million people aged 65 and older, will have a significant impact on the U.S. healthcare system. According to the Alzheimer's Association, Alzheimer's is the 7th leading cause of death in America with an estimated 5.3 million people of all ages currently having the disease.



Saturday September 11, is this year's Memory Walk. It is at a new location, Lincoln Park South Field, 1800 N. Stockton, in Chicago. Check in starts at 9a.m. and the Walk begins at 10a.m. Our club is already registered for the Walk thanks to our member and Memory Walk Captain, Bob Noonan.
