President Joe Klen called the meeting to order at 7:30

I hope everyone had a great St. Patrick's Day! I'd like to take a moment to thank Another Round Bar and Grill for hosting us this month. Don't forget, there's still time to enter the monthly raffle. Kathy just informed me that the jackpot has reached \$272.
