In attendance were President Joe Klen, Treasurer- Doug MacArtney, Secretary- John Sheridan, Social Director -Nancy Schreiner, - Membership Director Cheryl Wegner, and Kathy Sullivan- Charity Direc-

tor.

President Joe Klen called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

Joe thanked everyone for coming to the meeting. He also thanked Another Round and our servers for the night. He thanked Doug for running the video for the meeting.

He reminded everyone to buy tickets to the 50/50 raffle.

Joe thanked Cheryl and Jim for the tickets to the Buffett tribute concert at the Hollywood Bowl. Best concert he ever attended. The next item was the Chi.ill at the Beach in August.
