MARGARITAVILLE INDUCTED INTO THE LIBRARY OF CON-GRESS NATIONAL RECORDING REGISTRY



In case you missed it, the song Margaritaville has been inducted into the National Recording Registry. So what does the really mean?

The National Recording Registry was created to preserve our history through recorded sound for generations to come. There where 1100 nominations for 2023 and 25 recordings were selected. I guess you could say with 100% certainty—WE MADE HISTORY PARROTHEADS!! So far there are 625 recordings on the National Recording Registry.

Margaritaville was a top 10 hit in 1977 but as we know it has since become a pop culture staple and namesake of a chain of businesses and products.

Jimmy told the Library the key to the song's resonance in American culture was that people were looking for a song to make them feel good and be happy. "You're lucky enough at some point to put your thumb on the pulse of something that people can connect with, he said, "It's an amazing and lucky thing to happen to you and that happened with Margaritaville."
